

Participation Conditions

The Zentrum für Managementsimulation (ZMS) Stuttgart (Centre of Management Simulation) in cooperation with SAGSAGA awards excellent scientific theses concerning "Simulation and Gaming" with the German Simulation And Gaming Award. The purpose is to advance theory and practice of „Simulation and Gaming“. An application is possible with a final thesis of academic studies. There is also a special prize for Doctoral thesis, Dissertation or Habilitation.



How to participate

- > Application is possible with a thesis in form of Diploma, Bachelor, Master and Graduate etc. or with a Doctoral thesis, Dissertation or Habilitation.
- > The thesis has to discuss a theme concerning „Simulation and Gaming“.
- > The thesis has to be written in German or English.
- > The thesis must be submitted to a European University dating back no longer than three years before submission deadline.
- > You may not submit a thesis for German Simulation And Gaming Award for a second time.
- > Group, project or seminar theses that are not final theses cannot be submitted.
- > Theses can be submitted by third person. In this case the author's sign has to be given on the form.
- > Members of the ZMS or the jury are excluded of participation.

What we need

- > Electronic version (PDF-file) of the thesis.
- > In addition a written abstract (PDF-file) of the thesis (three pages maximum, five pages maximum for the special prize) including keynotes and results of the thesis.
- > The completed and signed application form must be submitted in writing (by mail).
- > All documents have to be submitted up to submission deadline (see www.g-sag-a.com) and remain at the ZMS.

How to be evaluated

- > Our jury consists of representatives of interdisciplinary science and practice.
- > Evaluation is based on the general accepted academic guidelines (esp. relevance of content and added value for science and / or practice).
- > Evaluation is not public and the decision is final.
- > The awardees are to be informed in written form after the decision (at least three weeks before award ceremony).

The prize

- > The best three theses will be awarded; there is also a special prize for Doctoral theses, Dissertation or Habilitation.
- > Prizes are awarded as „Deutscher Planspielpreis“ plus year of award.
- > The awardees receive a prize package including i.a. a free of charge membership in SAGSAGA or ISAGA for two years. More information about the prize package you find on the websites.
- > We also plan to publish outstanding papers.

Some more details

- > With submission the candidate accepts that
 - the thesis and bibliography will be collected in a list that will be published
 - the submitted abstract of awarded theses can be published on the websites of the ZMS and SAGSAGA in due form.
 - information of the awarded theses and of the awards ceremony (incl. photos) may be published.
- > Any recourse to courts of law is excluded.
- > The candidate is responsible that the thesis does not contain information which must not be disclosed to third parties.
- > With his application the candidate agrees with these conditions.
